SUBJECT : Designation of the Members of the Naga City Airshed Governing Board Located in the Province of Camarines Sur, Bicol Region

In the interest of public service and pursuant to Section 9 of the Republic Act 8749, otherwise known as the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999, and Section 4, Rule XV, Part V of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (DAO 2000-81) of the said Act and to effectively carry out the action plans, a Governing Board is hereby created, herein referred to as the Board.

The Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, as Chairman, shall head the Board.

There shall be one (1) Deputy Chairman, the Regional Director of Environmental Management Bureau-Region V.


The members of the Board shall be composed of the following:

- a. The Provincial Governor of Camarines Sur
- b. The City Mayor of Naga City
- c. The Regional Directors of the following:
 1. Land Transportation – Department of Transportation & Communication
 2. Department of Health
 3. Department of Trade and Industry
 4. Department of Interior and Local Government
 5. The Chief Meteorological Officer, Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical and Astronomical Service Administration
- d. The four (4) representatives from the private business sector;
- e. The four (4) representatives from the People's Organization and Non-governmental Organizations shall within six (6) months from the designation of the airshed, choose their representatives by and among themselves through sectoral assemblies concerned.

Members of the Governing Board shall serve for a term of three (3) years (or such lesser time as may be permitted by the term of Office, if publicly elected officials) without compensation except for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duty, subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

When a vacancy occurs during the term of a member from PO, NGO or Private Business Sector, the Governing Board shall appoint a new member for the remainder of the unfinished term.

This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately.
