DENR ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 2003- 54

SUBJECT: ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMUNITY ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICE (CENRO) BAYBAY, PROVINCE OF LEYTE

In order to improve the efficiency and effectiveness in the delivery of services to the clientele, the Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) Baybay, Leyte is hereby established pursuant to the provisions of Section 20 of Executive Order No. 192 dated June 10, 1987.

The CENRO Office of Baybay, Leyte, as established, shall exercise its functions within the administrative and territorial jurisdiction comprising the Municipalities of the 5th Congressional District of Leyte to wit: Baybay, Javier, Abuyog, Mahaplag, Inopacan, Hindang, Hilongos, Bato, and Matalom.

Personnel complement and financial requirement for the operation of the newly established CENRO Baybay shall come from the existing personnel and budget of the Region.

Upon the effectivity of this Order, the administrative and territorial jurisdiction of CENROs Palo and Albueria shall now be composed of the following municipalities:


